Ms. Diane M. Randon was inducted into the Senior Executive Service in June 2007. She has served in her current position as Deputy Chief of Staff for Installation Management since October 2012. Since July 2017, she is temporarily assigned performing the duties of Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Affairs.)

In this temporary position, Ms. Randon supports the Principal who is responsible for the supervision of manpower, personnel and Reserve Component affairs for the Department of the Army. She serves as the Army's point for policy and performance oversight of human resources (military, civilian and contractor), training, readiness, mobilization, military health affairs, force structure, manpower management, equal opportunity, equal employment opportunity and other critical matters as part of the Army leadership. Over 25 of her 32 years in federal service has been in resource and program management at a variety of assignments within the Department of the Army and Department of Defense, both in the continental United States and abroad. Ms. Randon most recently completed a certificate program in Leadership Coaching for Organizational Performance.
